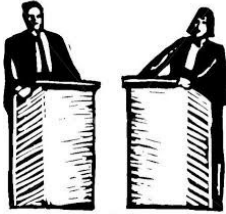
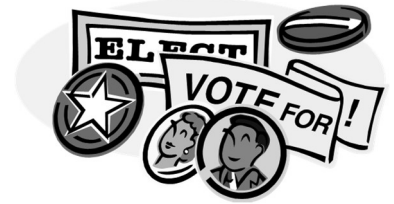


Request for Candidates' Forum Moderator
